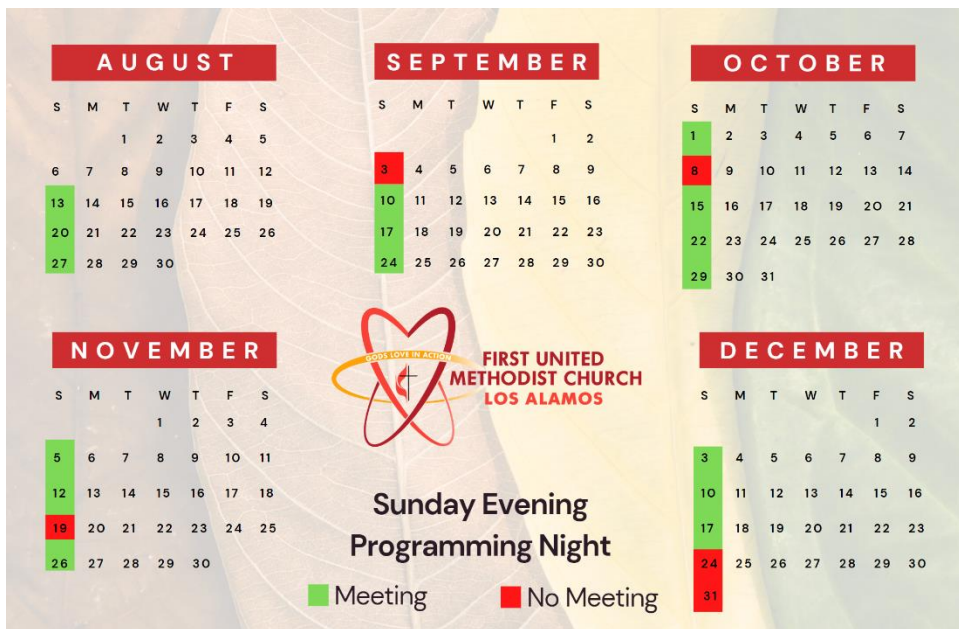
Here's the link for signing up for a meal. At this point Ted would like supper once a week with the possibility of some leftovers. They are medium sized eaters.
