Wednesday, July 3rd at 6:30 p.m. in the Friendship Center

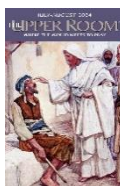
They will be available for streaming on our website, Disney+ and we have a copy in the church library. Los Alamos County Library also has copies.
